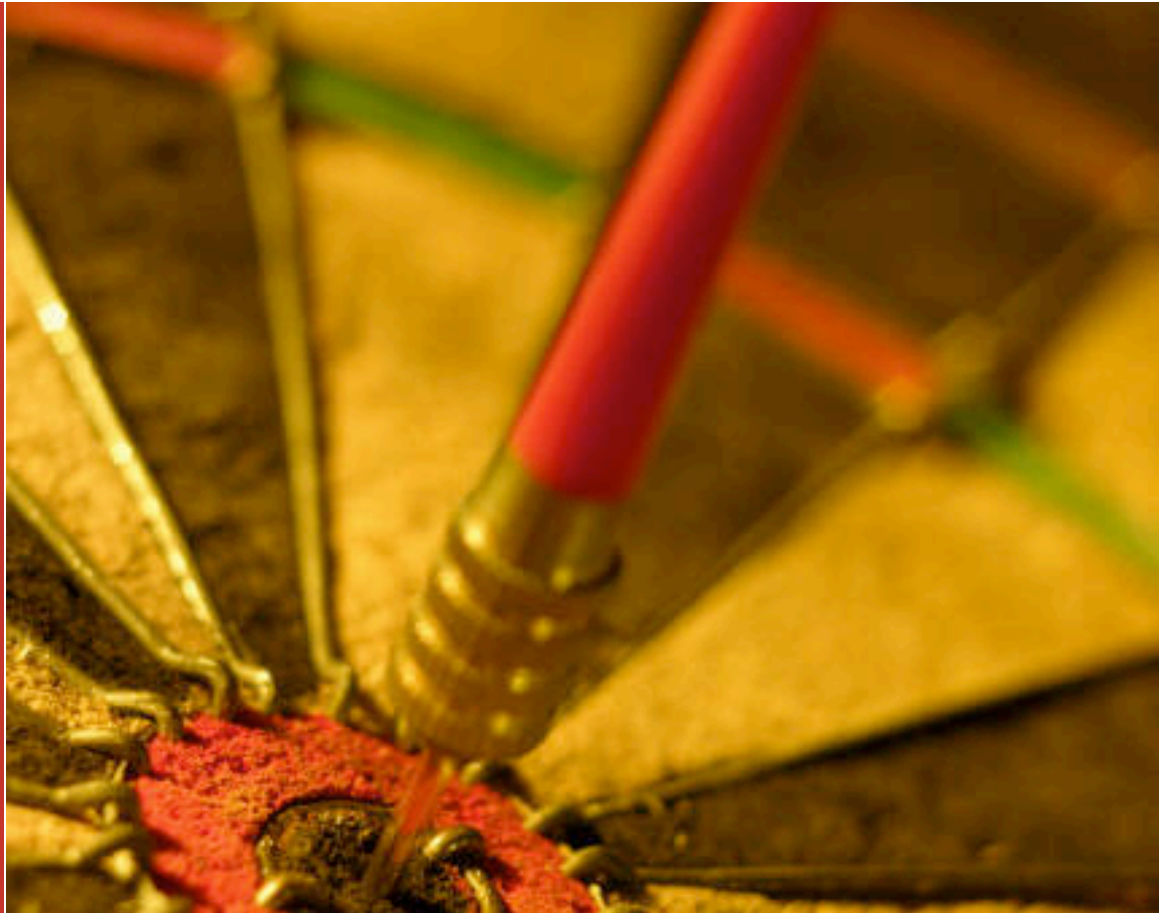

# First Serve Opportunities With South Side

<b>Administration</b>	<b>Interested in Finding Out More</b>
Serve as a receptionist and answer phones (2-4 hours, 1 day a week)	
Provide help with mailings and publications as needed (2-4 hours, 1 time a month)	

<b>Buildings &amp; Grounds</b>	<b>Interested in Finding Out More</b>
Help maintain the church vans with periodic cleaning and taking to vendors for service (2-4 hours, 1 time a month)	
Serve as member of the kitchen team to ensure it is clean and orderly. (1 hour a week for 4 weeks)	
Assist the facility manager in performing electrical, carpentry, maintenance or painting (As needed)	
Assist the grounds maintenance team with lawn mowing/trimming, flower gardening, etc. (2-4 hours monthly)	

<b>Student Ministry</b> These positions will require you to go through our youth workers screening process.	<b>Interested in Finding Out More</b>
Serve as a sponsor for Middle School Students on either Sunday mornings or Wednesday evenings	
Serve as a sponsor for High School Students on either Sunday mornings or Wednesday evenings	
Serve as a sponsor for the Bible Bowl program	
Help set up, perform crowd control and tear down for student ministry events	
Serve as a sponsor on student trips and conferences	

<b>Children's Ministry</b> These positions will require you to go through our children's workers screening process.	<b>Interested in Finding Out More</b>
Serve in the nursery on either Sunday mornings or Wednesday evenings (1 hour weekly)	
Serve as an class room assistant in one of our preschool age classrooms on either Sunday mornings or Wednesday evenings (1-2 hours weekly)	
Serve as an assistant for elementary age children's classroom on either Sunday mornings or Wednesday evenings (1-2 hours weekly)	
Serve as a drama actor or tech assistant with Kidstuf (2-4 hours weekly)	
Help create sets and decorate walls for special programs (as needed)	
Serve during Vacation Bible School as an assistant or helper. (evenings during 1 week in July)	

<b>Worship Ministry</b> These positions may require special training and/or an audition process.	<b>Interested in Finding Out More</b>
Sing as a member of the choir for worship services and special events such as the Christmas program	
Sing as a member of the praise team during worship services	
Play an instrument as part of a praise band during worship services	
Act in a drama to support worship services or special events	
Serve as a tech during worship services or special events in the areas of: sound, light, video or computer projection	
Serve communion during the worship service you normally attend	

<b>Outreach Ministry</b>	<b>Interested in Finding Out More</b>
Serve as a member of our First Impressions Team on Sunday mornings greeting people as they arrive (1 hour every other week)	
Prepare baked goods for the hospitality room on Sunday mornings (1 time a month)	
Join a team of 5-6 people that will do simple service projects in our community (1 project every 6 weeks)	

<b>Discipleship Ministry</b>	<b>Interested in Finding Out More</b>
Take communion to those who are homebound, in the hospital or an adult care center (1 time a month)	
Visit those that are in the hospital and/or those in that are home bound or in an adult care center (1 time a month)	
Serve as a volunteer at Lewis Memorial Christian Village (senior's home) doing various projects as needed (as needed)	
Help with food preparation for the Wednesday night Prime Time meal (2-3 hours, 1 time a month)	
Drive the church van on Sunday mornings to pick up special needs adults for church services/class (1-2 hours, 1 time a month)	
Help organize and lead a sports event/team or other recreational activities (seasonal)
